

How is Christ the one and only door to eternal life with God? In Jesus' own words:

John 10:9, "I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture."

Why?

John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."

John 17:3, "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."

1 Timothy 2:5, "There is one God and one Mediator between God and men, *the* Man Christ Jesus."

As such:

Colossians 1:15, "He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation."


Acts 4:12, "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." What's more?

John 3:17, "God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him."

Therefore:

John 3:36, "He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

John 12:48, "He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him, the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day."



Why did Jesus declare in John 14:6, "I am the truth?"

1 Corinthians 8:6, "There is one God, the Father, of whom *are* all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom *are* all things, and through whom we live."

1 John 5:20, "We know that the Son of God has come, and He has given us understanding so that we can know the true God. And now we live in fellowship with the true God because we live in fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ. He is the only true God, and He is eternal life."

As such:

Psalm 119:160, "The entirety of Your word *is* truth, and every one of Your righteous judgments *endures* forever."

The reason Jesus added:

John 4:24, "God *is* Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

John 8:31-32, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

And to the Father He said:


John 17:17, "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth."

What's more?

Hebrews 5:9, "He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him."

Therefore:

Psalm 86:11, "Teach me your ways, O LORD, that I may live according to your truth! Grant me purity of heart, so that I may honor You."



How did Jesus describe that He is the life in God?

John 11:25, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live."

John 3:36, "He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

John 17:3, "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."

John 6:35, "Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst."

John 6:63, "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and *they* are life."


As such:

Romans 6:23, "The wages of sin *is* death, but the gift of God *is* eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

1 John 5:11-12, "And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life."

Therefore, abiding in Christ means that:

Galatians 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."



How did Jesus declare that He is the Spiritual Light to lead us into eternal life with God?

John 8:12, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

How does the light of Christ lead us to eternal life?

2 Corinthians 4:6, "For God, who said, 'Let light shine out of darkness,' made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ."

What's more?

1 John 1:5, "This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all." As such:


1John 1:6-7, "If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin."

Psalm 119:130, "The entrance of Your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple."

Therefore:

Ephesians 5:13-14, "All things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light. Therefore He says: "Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light."

Matthew 5:16, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."



How evidently does scripture declare that Jesus is the Word of God? John 1:2-4, "He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men."

John 1:14, "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth."

As such Jesus said:

John 3:17-18, "God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."

John 5:39, "You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me."


John 17:17, "Your Word is truth."

What's more?

2 Timothy 3:16-17, "All Scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work."

Therefore:

Matthew 4:4, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God."



How does the Word of God define Jesus as being the Son of God, in other words, the very image of God?

John 1:1, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."

What's more?

Colossians 1:15, "He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation."

Hebrews 1:1-2, "God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days spoken to us by *His* Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds."

As such Jesus said:

John 8:58, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM." John 14:6, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

John 14:9, "He who has seen Me has seen the Father."

Matthew 11:27, "All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. Nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and *the one* to whom the Son wills to reveal *Him.*"

And the purpose is:

John 20:31, "These are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name."

Therefore:

John 12:26, "If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also."



How does the Word of God define Christ as the only path to salvation? John 3:16, "God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."

Romans 5:8, "God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Acts 4:12, "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." As such:

Hebrews 5:9, "Having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him."


2 Corinthians 5:17, "If anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

To this Jesus clearly declared:

John 8:24, "I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins."

Therefore:

Hebrews 12:1-2, "Let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."



Why must Jesus be Lord of our life if we profess to believe in Him as Savior?

Luke 9:23, "He said to *them* all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me." Why?

Luke 9:24, "For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it."

What's more?

Philippians 2:9-11, "God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

As such:

1 Corinthians 8:6, "Yet for us *there is* one God, the Father, of whom *are* all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom *are* all things, and through whom we live."


The reason Jesus warned us about living by the flesh while claiming to believe in Him, saying:

Luke 6:46, "Why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do the things which I say?"

Matthew 7:21, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven."

Therefore:

John 10:27, "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me."



How must we follow Christ, so we abide in Him and He in us?

1 John 2:3-4, "Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. He who says, 'I know Him,' and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him."

As such Jesus said:

Matthew 16:24, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me." John 15:14, "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you."

John 15:8, "By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples."

Why?

Luke 6:40, "A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his teacher."

1 Peter 2:21, "For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps."

Then Jesus added:

John 15:6, "If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw *them* into the fire, and they are burned."

Therefore:

John 8:31-32, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

As such we must:

2 Corinthians 10:5, "Bring every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ."
